Food and drink...

It is important that everyone drinks water during the day, so please make sure your child has a **drink bottle** to use at school. Often the students get hungry during class time, so we allow them to eat **fresh fruit** or **vegetables** any time of the day. If you are able to, please provide them with some to eat each day.

Homework...

READING – For homework, it is expected that your child reads for at least 20 minutes **every night**. They should bring a levelled reader home **each night** to read. The students can also borrow books from the library during our weekly library lesson. If they are not reading at home **every night**, please question them about why they are not doing this.

SIGHT WORDS – Your child will be given a list of ten common words to learn. Each week they will be tested on them. If they can read these words **fluently**, they will be given a new list of words to learn. The students should be learning these at home **each night**. It is helpful if they practice **both reading** and **writing** their words.

*There may be additional homework given sometimes. Please support your child with their homework by **listening to them read** and with **practicing their sight words**. We ask that you ensure they are doing these homework activities **each night**. The tasks don't take long and will help with their progress in the program. Thankyou.*
