HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

Daily Reading – Each child has a reading log in their take home folder (pencil case). Please sign off that your child has read each night. The students are responsible for writing in their log and asking you to sign it.

Word Study – Each Monday students will write their focus words in their homework books. Students are to practice the spelling of their words out loud. There is no written homework for spelling.

Homework Grid – A homework grid will be sent home every 5 weeks. Students are to complete 3 activities per week. You must sign on the activity to confirm that your child completed that task. More info about this in homework books.



School-home communication

This year students have diaries for communication between school and home. Please make sure you check your child's diary regularly. If you write a note in your child's diary please let them know so they can show me.
