HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

Water, Healthy Food and Allergies

PLEASE make sure your child has a drink bottle filled with water EVERY DAY. It is very important that students have access to water during lesson times, especially Physical Education lessons.

It has been great to see the children bringing all their healthy foods to school!

A reminder that we have a number of students at Ingle Farm Primary School this year with severe allergies to nuts. No nut products are to be brought to school. Bananas, eggs and sesame seeds are also high on the allergy list this year. Children are asked to wash their hands with soap and use hand sanitiser after eating these products, which must only be consumed in the classroom (not in the yard).

School Uniform

As a part of our uniform policy to show school pride and create a positive school culture, students must wear uniform every day.

School uniform includes:

- T-shirts, jumpers and jackets with school logo.
- Plain navy blue or red t-shirts, jumpers, jackets, pants, leggings, shorts, skirts or dresses.
