TERM 2 LEARNING & THE CURRICULUM

English: This term our writing genre is narrative texts. Students will plan, draft and publish imaginative texts using particular language features to convey creative ideas.

Math: In math we will be looking at Fractions & Decimals as well as Money & Financial math. We will also be reviewing Pattern & Algebra.

Science: Students will be exploring Earth & Space Sciences with a focus on geological changes, extreme weather events and Earth's resources.

HASS: We will have a focus on Geography looking at Water in the world (linking with Science) and diversity in Australia.

Digital Tech: Looking at algorithms/programming starting with Bee-bots.

Health/Child Protection Curriculum: Focusing on mental health/well being.
