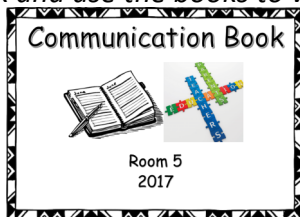

Homework Expectations

Daily Reading - Children are expected to read everyday. Your child will bring home 3 readers each week which will be recorded each Tuesday. Please ensure your child brings their tartan reader folder to school each day.

High frequency words - Each Monday students will have a list of words added in their homework book. Students practice using Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check each day. I expect they can start writing their words into sentences. Please see me if you are unsure about this process.
