### Student information

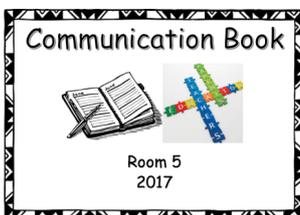

### Homework Expectations

**Daily Reading** - Children are expected to read everyday. Your child will bring home 3 readers each week which will be recorded each Tuesday. Please ensure your child brings their tartan reader folder to school each day.

**High frequency words** - Each Monday students will have a list of words added in their homework book. Students practice using Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check each day. Students have worked on making sentences and using capitals and full stops. Please see me if you are unsure about this process.
