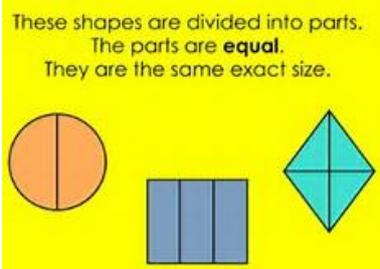
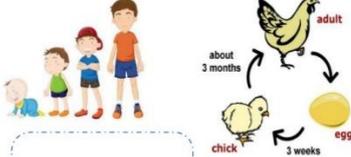

<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Writing Focus will be Information Reports. Students will learn the purpose, structure and organization of information reports.</p> <p>Spelling focus will be on high frequency words, digraphs, and building word families.</p> <p>Guided reading groups will focus on reading strategies like 'chunking' and 'reading on'. Children will explore fractions and partitioning, features of shapes and some measurement areas this term. This part of the Biological Science strand will help lead students to a better understanding about how animal adaptations help them survive in their habitats.
