

Uniform Policy

Governing Council supports the wearing of school uniform by all students at all times.

At Ingle Farm Primary School it is **expected** that all children will wear a top of navy blue or red. Students are strongly encouraged to adhere to all aspects of the school's dress code.



The wearing of a school uniform promotes pride in our school, enhances our public image, reduces peer pressure, encourages appropriate clothing for school activities and promotes a sense of equal opportunity.



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LISTED BELOW ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH OUR DRESS CODE:

COMPLUSORY DRESS CODE:

Polo Shirts - red or navy blue (plain, no slogans) or school logo polo tops



T-Shirts/shirts - red or navy blue (plain, no slogans)

Jumpers/Windcheaters - red or navy blue (no slogans) or school logo hoodie/jacket



Footwear - Suitable sturdy footwear, shoes, sandals or sneakers, are required (**thongs, slip-on shoes or high heels are not permitted**).



Earrings - Studs and sleepers OK

Hat - broad-brimmed, bucket or legionnaire style hat



Students will be given a new school hat on enrolment



Replacements hats are available for purchase at the front office for \$5.

Students must wear a IFPS approved hat for all outside activities in terms 1 and 4.

Students not wearing a hat will be asked to play in a solid shade area.

STRONGLY ENCOURAGED DRESS CODE:

Trousers/cargo pants - navy blue

Shorts/cargo shorts - navy blue

Tracksuits - navy blue (no slogans)

Skirts- navy blue

Dresses - navy/white or red/white checked dress



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UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- ⇒ Midriff tops and tops that expose the shoulders
- ⇒ Ripped clothing (patches acceptable)
- ⇒ Mini skirts and brief shorts
- ⇒ Makeup , nail polish, fake tattoos and writing on arms
(unless for religious/special reasons)
- ⇒ Chunky jewellery, dangling earrings , chokers and piercings
(unless for religious/special reasons)
- ⇒ Caps & beanies
- ⇒ Tops with slogans/motifs larger than 5 square centimetres (unless school tops)

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE SCHOOL'S COMPLUSORY DRESS CODE WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLWING ACTION:

- ⇒ Any day a student is not wearing a top/dress in line with the dress code, they will be required to change into a clean second hand uniform top in the office at recess time. They will need to return this top at the end of the school day.
- ⇒ A note will be sent home with the student notifying parents/caregivers of this, with the expectation that they be appropriately dressed the following day.
- ⇒ Continued non-compliance with the dress code, will result in a member of the leadership team contacting the family.
- ⇒ If a student refuses to wear dress code, they will be unable to participate in yard play and excursions.

Families who needs assistance to support the Dress Code Policy, please see your child's teacher or a member of the leadership team.

Any new student at the school will be given a fortnight to organise their own school uniform. The school will supply these students with a temporary uniform to change into at school.
