Physical Education: Sports focus: baseball/ International games & dance from Action Pact

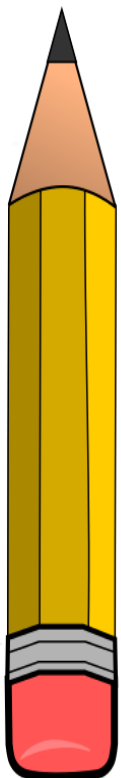
Health: Healthy eating and fire safety
