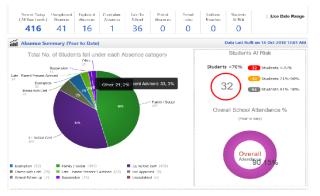
We utilise the Academy Education Solutions Portal for regular tracking, monitoring and reporting of attendance, supported by the Education Dashboard – Attendance Reports.













Academy is a web based portal that uploads directly to EDSAS. Teachers mark class rolls from a laptop, interactive whiteboard or tablet device. It is easy to use, with data available across our school instantly. Temporary Relief Teachers have roll marking access. It provides alerts for teachers for ongoing absences and improves school communication.

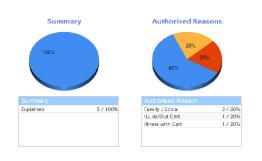

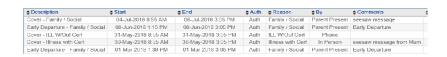

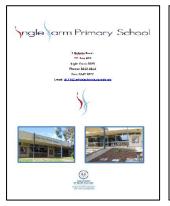




The Education Dashboard provides breakdown of attendance and absence rates by year level, gender, Aboriginal/non-Aboriginal and summary by calendar year.

On enrolment families are provided with information regarding attendance and processes to inform the school of reasons for absence, including exemption

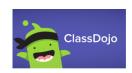
requirements.





Teachers will make contact with families if no reason for an absence has been provided. This may be via a communication book, online resource such as Class Dojo, Seesaw, Skoolbag or phone call. Teachers are required to phone a family if a student is absent for 3 or more consecutive days. Proactive information is also shared in newsletters and at Governing Council.





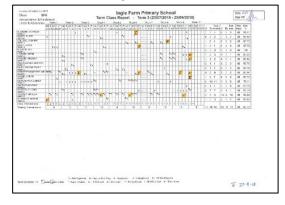






In the event of ongoing absences, a referral to our Aboriginal Education Community Officer and to the Department for Education Attendance and Engagement Social Worker may be enacted, fostering further connections with families to support re-engagement at school. Additional phone calls, letters home or family meetings may be established to determine strategies to foster increased attendance of students at school.

At the end of each term, all staff members review and sign the Termly Attendance Report and this is maintained on school file. Attendance records are reported back to families during parent/teacher interviews and biannual written reports.
