Dear Families

SA Health has provided advice to us about coronavirus, which is occurring in the Hubei Province of China and has also been reported in other parts of mainland China, and several other countries.

Our school is following advice provided from the [Department for Education](#)

Students who have travelled to mainland China, including those that have travelled to Hubei Province, may return to school unless:

- they have been in close contact of a confirmed case
- they have symptoms consistent with the virus.

Symptoms may include; fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, and sore throat. Anyone who travelled to mainland China, especially Hubei Province, should monitor possible symptoms for the 14 days from their departure.

People should take general measures to protect against infections including:

- washing hands
- covering mouths while coughing or sneezing
- avoiding contact with wild or farm animals.
