Communication between Home and School

Seesaw will be checked each night and not throughout the day so if there is something urgent please call the school front office directly on 8262 4864.

I will also have a communication folder/pencil case. All hard copy notices will be sent inside this communication folder so please check it each night for any important information. Each day these folders must be brought to class and placed in the communication tray at the front of the classroom.

If you would like to discuss something in person with me please feel free to make an appointment, I am always happy to discuss your child and their needs.

School bags and Morning Routines

Prior to entry to the classroom, your child will place their bag on the locker racks just outside the classroom. Inside the classroom your child will find a designated container to place their lunchbox and drink bottle. Please label these so they do not get lost. Please encourage your child to unpack and take their belongings inside as I wish to teach them responsibility and independence.
