It is important that your child drinks water throughout the day, so please send a water bottle to school. Please make sure they fill it before school starts.

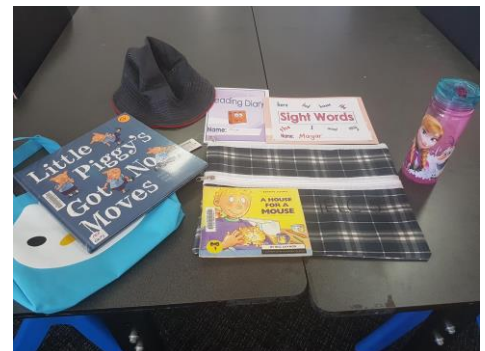


The school canteen will be open every day of the week. If your child needs to order their lunch orders need to be placed by 9:15am.
