ROOM 14 LEARNING FOCUS

Literacy: This term in Literacy we will be learning about Narratives. Our topic will be fairy Tales and Folk Tales.

Numeracy: This term in numeracy we will be learning about data interpretation and representation.

Spelling: In spelling we will continue learning about word patterns that help to spell, read and write.

Guided Reading: In guided reading we will be developing reading skills such as phonics, fluency and comprehension and using reading strategies.

Child Protection: This term our child protection topic is Growth and Development and Relationships.

OTHER SUBJECT AREAS

Science with Mrs Lakra: Students will learn to ask questions, make predictions, select appropriate investigation methods, and communicate solutions to problems.

Health with Mrs Lakra: Students will learn about healthy eating.

Physical Education with Mr Polvak: Students will engage in sports such as touch football, soccer and netball and work towards identifying key components of each sport. For the second part of the term they will engage in track and field activities in preparation for the schools athletics day.

The Arts with Mrs Carn: Students will learn and perform dance sequences to communicate meaning, and describe characteristics of dances from different social, historical and cultural contexts.



HOMEWORK

Reading: It is expected that your child reads for at least 20 minutes every night. They should bring a levelled reader home each night to read. The students can also borrow books from the library.

Sight words: Your child will be given a list of words to learn at home each night. It is helpful if they practise both reading and writing their words.

Maths: Every Tuesday your child will be given a maths mental homework which they will be expected to complete by Friday.

Spelling: On Mondays your child will receive a new list of spelling words. They are expected to complete a Look Say Cover Write Check (LSCWC) for these words every night.

REMINDERS

- Students need to wear the school uniform to school and all pants need to be navy blue.
- Our room is located in the Seniors building. If your child is late or absent, please remember to write a note explaining why they were away, send a message on Seesaw or ring the school.
- Our library day will now be on Thursdays. Students will need to return and borrow their library books on this day.
