CONTEXT

At Ingle Farm Primary School, we take pride in our school culture by promoting our sense of identity and community. This is consistent with our school values and includes the expectation that **all** students wear the Governing Council approved school uniform. Our school colours of **navy** and **red** (NO logos other than school logo). Clothing needs to be sun safe (covering shoulders) and in good condition (without tears and clearly labelled).

PROCEDURE

Staff monitor the wearing of uniform and communicate with families if items of clothing do not meet the policy. Families may seek an exemption by writing to the principal. Exemptions can be considered on the following grounds.

- religious
- cultural or ethnic
- new student (to allow time to purchase)
- financial hardship
- genuine medical or family sickness reasons

Students not wearing the correct uniform, who do not have an exemption or appropriate explanation, may be supplied with a second-hand item to be worn for that day. This includes excursions as school uniform ensures students are clearly visible for safety.

APPROVED SCHOOL UNIFORM

Items are available for purchase via the front office. See website for pricing. Clothing can also be purchased from retail stores in required school colours.

- polo tops
- navy bottoms (shorts, track pants, skorts, 3/4 pants **NOT** jeans)
- jackets
- jumpers/windcheaters plain school colours
- navy/red school dresses
- safe shoes suitable for Physical Education
- school bucket hat required all year (beanies acceptable in Terms 2 and 3)
- Year 6 tops are available each year - polo tops and fleece jackets.

*Students are expected to wear **minimal** jewellery for safety. Makeup and nail polish is **not** suitable at school and students may be supported to remove it.
